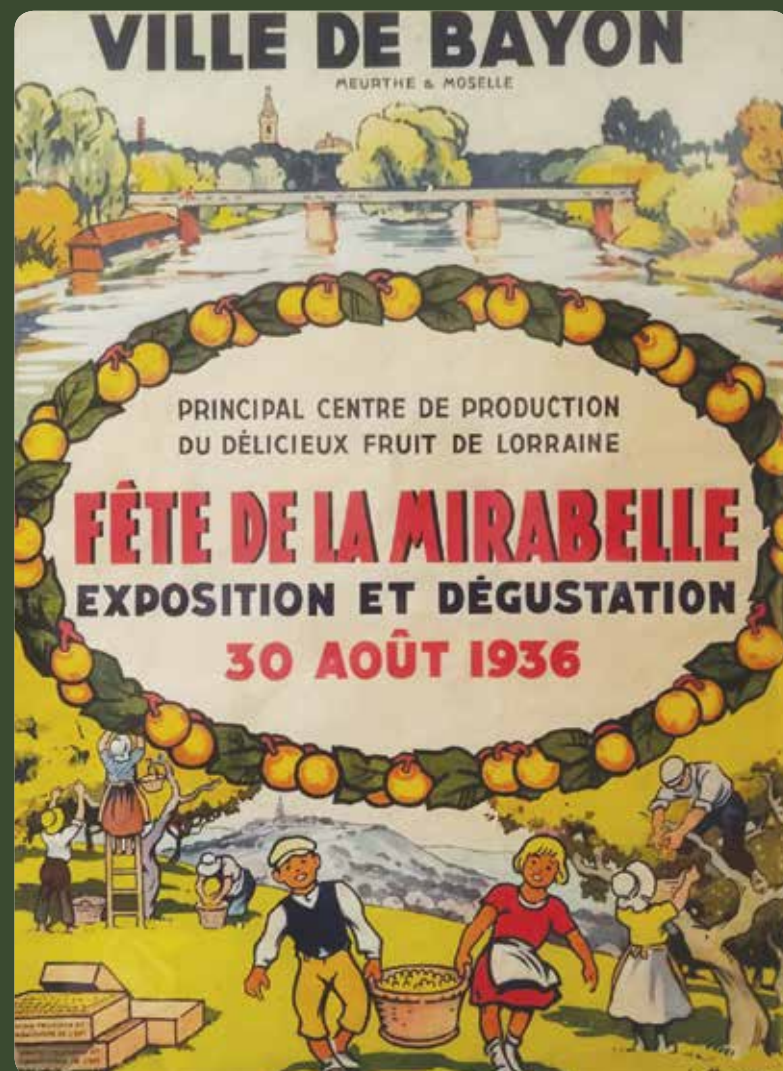


THE BAYONNAIS HILLS

It was in 1936, in the town of Bayon, that the *Mirabelle Festival* was held for the first time, an event celebrating the golden fruit. The Bayonnais region has revived this tradition thanks to the association *Les Mordus de la Mirabelle*, which has restored honor to our land and its orchards, blooming in spring and sweet in summer.
